MOST PROMISING BUSINESS

A new business or a new owner of a pre-existing business, established within the last two years

Describe how the business has demonstrated creativity and innovation, key achievements, challenges overcome and community involvement.

AGRICULTURAL BUSINESS AWARD

Farmers in the area dedicated to excellence in their field

Describe the farm's success in operation, markets, employee base, stability, strength of management, team leadership, family involvement, community involvement, future planning, human resource practices, integrity and consistency.

OIL AND GAS SERVICE INDUSTRY

Businesses serving the oil and gas sector

Describe the business's role, responsibilities and commitment to the oil and gas sector. Explain how they contribute to the success of the industry through quality sales and/or services, reputation and reliability. Describe how the business involves itself in the community.
